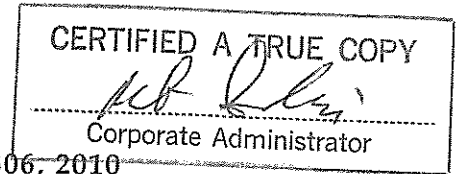

SOLID WASTE AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3306, 2010



A BYLAW TO AMEND THE "SOLID WASTE BYLAW NO. 3223, 2006"
FEE STRUCTURE FOR THE YEARS 2011, 2012 AND 2013.

The Council of the City of Prince Rupert, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:


1. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as the "Solid Waste Amendment Bylaw No. 3306, 2010."
2. The "Solid Waste Bylaw No. 3223, 2006" is hereby amended by replacing "Schedule E" - Fees and Charges in its entirety with the new Schedule "E" attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.
3. This bylaw shall come into effect on the date of its final adoption.
