ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3334, 2013

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT
ZONING BYLAW No. 3286, 2009 – Antenna Systems Policy

The Council of the City of Prince Rupert, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

That the City of Prince Rupert Zoning Bylaw No. 3286, 2009 be amended as follows:

1. By amending Section 3.5.0 Siting Exceptions as follows:
 - (a) Freestanding lighting poles, warning devices, utility poles, wires, flag poles, signs and sign structures may be sited on any portion of a lot, except as otherwise limited in other bylaws.
2. By amending 3.6.0 Height Exceptions as follows:

The heights of buildings and structures permitted elsewhere in this Bylaw may be exceeded for, retaining walls, church spires, monuments, chimney and smokestacks, flagpoles, stadium bleachers, lighting poles, apartment elevator shafts and stair towers.
3. By adding Section 3.13.0 Antenna Systems as follows
All exterior transmitting device – or group of devices – used to receive and/or to transmit radio-frequency (RF) signals, microwave signals, or other federally-licensed communications energy transmitted from, or to be received by, other antennas and including a supporting tower, mast or other supporting structure, and an equipment shelter are regulated by the City of prince Rupert Antenna Siting Policy. This includes Freestanding Antenna System and Building/Structure-Mounted Antenna System.
4. This Bylaw may be cited as **“ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3334, 2013”**.


