

CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT

ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3398, 2016

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT ZONING BYLAW NO. 3286, 2009 TO REGULATE A MINIMUM 1 KM. DISTANCE BETWEEN LIQUOR SALES ESTABLISHMENTS.

The Council of the City of Prince Rupert in an open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

That the City of Prince Rupert Zoning Bylaw No. 3286, 2009 be amended as follows:

1. That Section 3 – General Provisions - be amended to include a new Subsections:

3.14.0 Retail Liquor Sales

No retail liquor sales may occur within 1 km. of another liquor sales establishment as measured in a straight line from primary entrance to primary entrance.

2. That in all Commercial Zones (C1, C2, C3, C4, C5 AND C6) the Special Provisions Section be amended to include the following clause:

Retail liquor sales are subject to Section 3 - General Provisions, Subsection 3.14.0

This Bylaw may be cited as **“Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 3398, 2016”**.
