Update from Council Meeting — November 9th, 2015

- ⇒ At this week's Council meeting, Council heard a report from the Mayor on the progress being made by the City's Housing Committee. The City is working with the Housing Committee with the goal of developing an affordable housing project on a City-owned lot. The membership of the Committee includes the Prince Rupert Aboriginal Services Society, Hecate Strait Employment Development Society, the City of Prince Rupert, and potentially the Prince Rupert Transition Society. The City is now working to identify an appropriate lot, the costs and scope of the project, and preparing to petition the Province for funding to complete the project.
- ⇒ Councillor Blair Mirau will be attending the Children's Fit for Communities Forum on behalf of the City and will provide an update at the next meeting
- ⇒ The Mayor briefly reported on his attendance at the N2N (Nation to Nation) summit in Terrace last week, which brought First Nations leaders together from across Northern BC and was focused on building modern-day First Nations partnerships.
