COUNCIL CORNER

Update from Council Meeting — February 20th, 2017

- ⇒ Council held a Committee of the Whole session to hear petitions and delegations from the public.
- ⇒ Council heard report from the Community Planner **regarding an Application for a Development Variance Permit for 125 Kootenay Place**. Council voted to allow the permit to proceed to the public notification process.
- ⇒ Council voted in favour of writing a **letter of support regarding a petition from the Northwest Community College Student's Union, BC Federation of Students, Local 14, to endorse BC Federation of Students' campaign to save adult basic education Don't Close the Door**, and to write a letter to Minister Andrew Wilkinson stating the City's support for Adult Basic Education programs.
- ⇒ Council voted in favour of writing **letters of support to the Kaien Island Trail Enhancement and Recreation Society (KITEARS), the North Coast Transition Society, and the North Pacific Cannery Historical Site for their respective funding applications**.
- ⇒ Council heard a report from the Director of Operations regarding 3rd Avenue West Road Closure – Bylaw No. 3391, 2016, and **adopted the Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw No. 3391, 2016 with respect to the closure of a section of Road on 3rd Avenue West**.
