## COUNCIL CORNER

### Update from Council Meeting — October 24th, 2016

- ⇒ Devlin Fernandes and Jean Pogge from **EcoTrust Canada** made a **presentation to Council about the programming** they provide to Prince Rupert and other areas.
- ⇒ Council heard an **update from Pacific Northwest LNG regarding the Canadian Environmental Assessment Authority report on their project**. The company stated that their shareholders are currently reviewing the 190 conditions provided by the CEAA as well as economic considerations before making a Final Investment Decision on the project.
- ⇒ The City Planner reported to Council on a **development variance permit to increase the height of the new yacht club building to be built at 120 George Hills Way**, and Council approved the application to proceed to public notification.
- ⇒ Council heard a report from the Director of Operations on two **applications proposed for the Clean Water and Wastewater Fund (CWWF)**. **The applications, which were supported by Council, will be made to fund Phase 2 and 3 of the water supply project:** the replacement of our 100 year old Woodworth Dam, and the submarine lines that carry the City's potable water below Fern Passage. Phase 1 of the project to replace the supply line from the dam to the waterfront and develop an access road to the dam has already secured grant funding and will proceed within the next 6 months.
- ⇒ Council passed a resolution to grant the Bank of Montreal an in-kind donation of **free ice time in order to support their fund-raising event for the local food bank**.
- ⇒ **A resolution regarding the PNW LNG project forwarded by Councillor Thorkelson at the previous meeting was tabled** until the following meeting.
