USE IN ALL ZONES

RECOMMENDATIONS:

THAT following the Public Hearing at Council's Regular Meeting, Council considers giving Third Reading and Adopts the Interim Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 3419, 2017.

REASON FOR REPORT:

Council in their Regular Meeting of November 14th, 2017 received a report from staff recommending the consideration of Bylaw 3419, 2017. Council gave First and Second Readings to the Bylaw at that time, and scheduled a Public Hearing for December 11th, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.

BACKGROUND:

The report to Council presented on November 14th, 2017 described the purpose and rationale for the proposed Bylaw. In short:

- Council previously passed Bylaw 3408 which temporarily established commercial marijuana operations as a prohibited use in all zones.
- Bylaw 3408 was passed with a sunset clause of January 1, 2018, by which point it
 was understood that the Provincial and Federal legal frameworks for marijuana
 legalization would be established.
- The Federal Government now intends to pass legislation legalizing recreational marijuana by July 1, 2018.

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• The proposed bylaw would amend the previous zoning prohibition against commercial marijuana activities to expire on July 1, 2018.

Public notification of this Bylaw has been published in the local newspaper, and posted publicly at City Hall. The public are invited to provide comment on this proposed amendment at the public hearing of December 11, 2017.

COST:

The cost of advertising and staff time.

CONCLUSION:

Council can proceed to the final consideration of the Interim Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 3419, 2017.

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE INTERIM ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3408, 2016 TO TEMPORARILY ESTABLISH COMMERCIAL MARIJUANA OPERATIONS AS A PROHIBITED USE IN ALL ZONES
