Sidewalk renewal on 3rd Avenue continues

Contractors continue to work on sidewalks in the 100 Block of 3rd Avenue West.



Rushbrook Boat Launch is Open!

Residents will see major enhancements to the Rushbrook Improvement Area. Construction delayed the re-opening last week, however it is now open. Boaters are requested to use the area with caution, as curbing on the lower sections of the ramp is incomplete and limited. Remaining work will be completed within the next couple of months during the low tide cycle.



Sewer main replacement

City Crews continue to work on the extensive sewer main replacement on Bellis Road and Seal Cove Road. This capital improvement will tie into the new road work and retaining wall in the 2200 Block of Seal Cove. The project is nearing completion and we thank the public for their patience with the traffic interruptions.



Landfill site

The East berm expansion at the land fill site is complete, and the City is in the process of closing the old cell. Adventure Paving completed paving the road from the entrance to the Scale House and it was widened to allow for better traffic flow. There will also be new signage installed to better indicate where, and which items are permitted for disposal.



Water main break at Applewhaite Drive

Bus stops surrounding Applewhaite Drive are now open, and the water main has been repaired. The next step for City crews is repaving the opening caused by the break.
