Seal Cove Retaining Wall Construction Commencing November 3rd

Construction on a retaining wall, located from 2149 – 2222 Seal Cove Circle, will commence November 3rd. Broadwater Industries was awarded the contract, and their crews have now started to remove the old existing retaining wall. The project is expected to finish in mid-late December. The road will be closed to the public until construction is complete. Area residents who will be impacted by construction have now been notified.



Sidewalk renewal on 3rd Avenue continues

Workers are currently working on 3rd Avenue in the McBride Street area—eventually repaving the sidewalks as far as 3rd Avenue and 8th Street.



Rushbrook Launch closed for improvements

The City Public Works Department is undertaking major improvements to the Rushbrook boat launch. From Wednesday, October 28, 2015 until Thursday, November 5, 2015 the public boat launch area will be closed to replace the existing deteriorated ramp.



Sewer main replacement

The sewer main on Bellis Road and Seal Cove Road is currently being replaced by Public Works staff due to a collapsed sewer main, estimated to be complete within the next two weeks.



Fraser Street renewal project

This project, which replaced the water, sewer, storm drains, roads and sidewalks at Fraser Street and Grenville Court is nearing completion. Finishing touches such as sidewalk and street lines will be painted shortly, taking into consideration weather.



Landfill site

A new cell of additional landfill space at the existing landfill site is nearing completion.
