Withdrawal of Candidates

Candidates may reconsider and withdraw their candidacy by 4:00 pm Friday, September 21, 2018. Withdrawal may be affected by delivering a signed withdrawal to the Chief Election Officer, who must be satisfied of its authenticity. After that time a candidate may only withdraw by delivering a signed request to withdraw to the Chief Election Officer and receiving the approval from the Minister.
