BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT QUALITY OF LIFE
OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN BYLAW NO. 3236, 2007

The Council of the City of Prince Rupert in an open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

That the City of Prince Rupert Quality of Life Official Community Plan of Bylaw No. 3236, 2007 be amended as follows:

1. That a portion of newly created lot described as BLOCK A DISTRICT LOT 8147 RANGE 5 COAST DISTRICT be changed:

From: Open Space
To: Business Industrial
2. That the Long Range Land Use Plan Map 1 which forms a part of the Quality of Life Official Community Plan No. 3236, 2007, shall be amended according to Schedule “A”, attached and forming part of the Bylaw No. 3436, 2019
3. This Bylaw may be cited as **“Quality of Life Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 3436, 2019”**



