CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 3387, 2016

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT BYLAW NO. 2944, 1995 TO ESTABLISH THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF TRAINING REQUIRED FOR FIRE SERVICES PERSONNEL

The Council of the City of Prince Rupert in an open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

That the City of Prince Rupert Bylaw No. 2944, 1995 be amended as follows:

- 1. THAT the Playbook be added as Schedule "B" which establishes the minimum level of sequential training and operational requirements of the Level of Service which must be met by the City's Fire Department.
- 2. THAT Section 4.10 of the City of Prince Rupert Bylaw No. 2944, 1995 be amended as follows:
 - 4.10 The Fire Department shall maintain the Level of Service as defined by the Playbook (attached as Schedule "B") and as is appropriate to community needs under the confinements of the community's economic ability to maintain and improve that Level of Service.
- 3. THAT the following Definitions of the City of Prince Rupert Bylaw No. 2944, 1995 be amended to include and to amend the following:
 - 2.22.1 "Level of Service" shall mean Full Service Operations as defined in the Playbook.
 - 2.26.1 "Playbook" shall mean the British Columbia Fire Service Minimum Training Standards, Structure Firefighters Competency and Training Playbook, being the mandatory minimum training standards set under paragraph 3(3)(b) of the *Fire Services Act* (B.C.) and as may be amended, revised or replaced from time to time by the Office of the Fire Commissioner and approved by the Minister of Justice.
- 4. This Bylaw may be cited as "Fire Control and Protection Amendment Bylaw No. 3387, 2016".
