You will also support the implementation of the Asset Management Strategy and related Data Governance Framework by assisting with the capture, management, and maintenance of asset data to set standards and ensure its viability for future uses. - Provide support to the Development Services Department from an operations perspective, including the interpretation and review of civil plans, recommendations for servicing support on land-use permits, and facilitating data requests;

- Work closely with the GIS Specialist to manage the acquisition and integration of new asset information, as it relates to development and operations, following the City's Data Governance Framework;
- Prepare custom reports, graphics, charts, plans, and documents to support development;

- Engineering Technologist Degree or BEng, or equivalent experience. A BSc in Applied Sciences, Geography or Environmental Studies or a related discipline from a recognized university with Canadian accreditation may also be considered with adequate understanding of civil plan review;

- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's License.
- Proficiency in reading and interpreting civil plans;
- Familiarity with MMCD Standards, municipal permitting processes, and asset management theory and practice;
- Demonstrated proficiency in CAD software (e.g. Autodesk Suite);
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office suite;
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills with a commitment to teamwork and customer service;
