TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The applicant (owner) is hereby authorized to proceed with the placement of a shipping container as described in the details on page 1. All works must be performed in accordance with the following conditions and regulations, the applicant's plans as approved, and the City's bylaws.

Liability and Indemnity

The applicant agrees that it will indemnify and save harmless the City of Prince Rupert and its officials, officers, employees, servants and agents from all costs, losses, damages, compensation and expenses (including legal fees) of any nature whatsoever suffered or incurred by the City and sustained or caused by the applicant's occupation or possession of the Premises, and from all claims, demands, suits and judgements against the City and its officials, officers, employees, servants and agents, or either of them, on account of or in respect of the Premises or the occupation or possession or use thereof by the applicant, its servants, agents, contractors, licensees or permittees.

Existing Utilities

The applicant shall comply with the requirements specified by the utility operators, make every effort to confirm the location of the existing utilities in the area, and take all precautions necessary to prevent damage. Any damage and subsequent repairs to existing utilities as a result of the shipping container placement shall be the responsibility of the applicant.

Tree Cutting

No tree cutting will be permitted on City Property unless specifically approved through a *Tree Cutting or Removal Permit*. If required by this permit, the applicant shall acquire a Tree Cutting or Removal Permit from the Development Services Department. A copy of the Permit is to be submitted to the City of Prince Rupert Engineering Department prior to the start of the shipping container placement.

Public Access

The applicant shall not hinder or block access to neighbouring property during the shipping container placement.

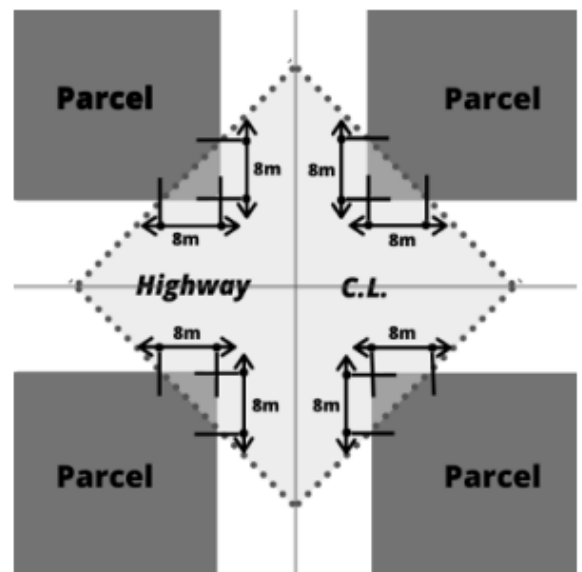
Sight Triangle

A corner parcel shall not obstruct the line vision above 0.5 meters of an established grade of a highway that is within the sight triangle. This is calculated by extending an 8 metre boundary along each edge of the corner of the parcel. This is applicable to all zones unless otherwise specified.

Maintenance

The Permittee agrees to relocate the container at their cost should it be necessary for the City to perform work in that area.

Upon removal of the container, the Permittee agrees to repair all municipal infrastructure affected by the container and return it to an equal or better condition.
