CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT

BYLAW NO. 2783

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL TICKETING INFORMATION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS section 934.1 of the Municipal Act authorizes Council, by bylaw, to:

- A. designate those bylaws which may be enforced by means of a form of ticket, from among those bylaws prescribed by regulation under section 934.3 (a) of the Municipal Act;
- B. designate as a bylaw enforcement officer those persons who come within the class prescribed by regulation under section 934.3 (b) of the Municipal Act;
- C. designate an offence against a municipal bylaw by means of any word or expression on a ticket; and
- D. after consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court, set a fine, not exceeding \$500, for contravention of a designated bylaw.

AND WHEREAS the Council has consulted with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court with regard to the fines set out in this bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of City of Prince Rupert in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed by the regulations adopted pursuant to section 934.3 (c) of the Municipal Act.
- 2. The persons who act in the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule "A" to this bylaw are designated bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" opposite the respective job position.
- 3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules "B" through "H" of this bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 of Schedules "B" through "H" opposite the respective words or expressions.

4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules "B" through "H" of this bylaw are the fines for contravention of the bylaw offence set out in Column 1 of Schedules "B" through "H" of this bylaw.
5. Subsections 10.01, 10.03, 10.04, 10.10, 10.11 and 11.12 of City of Prince Rupert Traffic Bylaw No. 2470, 1983, as amended, are hereby deleted, the remaining subsections of section 10 are hereby renumbered, and renumbered subsection 10.01 is hereby amended by replacing the amount of "\$1,000.00" with "\$2,000.00" and by replacing the amount of "\$50.00" with "\$20.00".
6. Subsections 6.02 (a) and 6.02 (b) of City of Prince Rupert Trade or Business Licence Bylaw 2426, 1982, as amended, are deleted, and the following is inserted as subsection 6.02 (a):

"A person who commits an offence against this bylaw is liable on conviction to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$2,000.00."

and the remaining subsections of 6.02 are renumbered.
7. Subsection 11.1 of City of Prince Rupert Building Bylaw No. 2420, 1982 as amended, is hereby amended by replacing the words "Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)" with the words "Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)".
8. Section 12 of City of Prince Rupert Nuisance Prohibition Bylaw No. 2709, 1990 is deleted and the following is substituted in its place:

"Any person convicted of an offence under this Bylaw shall be liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$75.00 and not more than \$2,000.00, to imprisonment for a period not greater than six months, or to both."

10. Deleted by Bylaw No. 2951.
11. This bylaw may be cited as "City of Prince Rupert Ticket Information Bylaw No. 2783, 1992".
